The pandemic of HIV/AIDS since 1981 had also claimed more than 32 millions of people's lives to death, until now. There are many more pandemic diseases that had caused millions of fatality in the past. The present Covid-19 pandemic that began in December 2019 spread fast across all the countries in the world (except 2/3 countries that have not reported) and had affected more than 279 millions of people across the world and lead to fatality of more than 5 millions of people. Thanks to the development of the medical sciences, healthcare system, scientific research teams, government policies, public awareness, more than 249 millions have recovered from this deadly disease.

Covid-19 pandemic has severely affected the normal life of everyone in the world due to restriction in public gathering, travels, shutting down of educational institutions and marketplaces etc. What do we learn?
