Science in the midst of struggle

Across three powerful days, Kyiv's Mercure Congress Hall became a vibrant epicenter of cutting-edge ophthalmology. From retinal surgery masterclasses to complex case symposia, discussions spanned technologies, techniques, and personal experiences. International speakers, including experts from Brazil, Pakistan, Germany, the USA, and Poland, shared insights that transcended borders.

Yet it was the Ukrainian voices that struck the deepest chords. Presenters from Kharkiv, Chernihiv, Zaporizhzhia, Dnipro and Odesa cities scarred by war - stood on stage not only as scientists, but as survivors. Their research was shaped by urgency, their clinical stories marked by patients whose lives were changed not just by disease, but by missile strikes and loss.

The silent themes: War, trauma, and healing

One of the most emotionally stirring moments came during sessions that addressed the war directly. Dr. Alina Osharova's presentation on the link between depression and dry eye disease as a consequence of full-scale war was more than a lecture - it was a mirror to the collective psychological burden.

And when Dr. Jorge Corona from the USA presented "Restoring Hope: The Experience of Eye Reconstruction after the Conflict in Ukraine", the room fell into reverent silence. These weren't just cases. They were lives - lives interrupted by trauma and rebuilt with skill and compassion.

Strength in community

Despite everything, this was a conference filled with warmth. In between the packed sessions were reunions between colleagues, hugs that lingered longer than usual, and conversations laced with both laughter and shared sorrow.
